

- use of force; revising and updating police crowd dispersal techniques; improving the quality and depth of cultural competency and racial equity training among all public-serving agencies; and setting a timeline to execute the other recommendations in both reports.
- Advocate that Governor DeWine, Ohio Senate President Obhof and Ohio Speaker Householder to emulate the leadership of Franklin County and the City of Columbus and declare racism as a public health crisis. Info here: <https://forms.gle/1qG93RUqVkcEFAX38>
 - Join with County and City leaders as they propose solutions to address health disparities stemming from racial inequities.
 - Directly communicate with people of color and those who often don't follow or trust mainstream media.
 - Cultivate and respond to the ideas and concerns of young leadership.
